
# 2024 Memorial Chair: Dr. Charles Montgomery

Dr. Charles "Chaz" Montgomery helped change the face of cancer care in north Mississippi. When beginning his career, Dr. Montgomery realized the undeniable need for cancer care in Tupelo and surrounding areas. Because of that, he co-founded North Mississippi Hematology and Oncology Associates in 1979. Throughout his 44-year career, Dr. Montgomery treated numerous patients, including some colleagues and close friends, with dignity and his famous smile. Dr. Sam Pace said, "Dr. Chaz Montgomery consistently and compassionately cared for thousands of patients with cancer, and I was one of them. Our families were friends throughout medical school and residency, and when I was diagnosed with colon cancer, he masterfully guided me through the treatments that led to successful results."

Dr. Montgomery was a hero not only to his patients, but to his colleagues and coworkers as well. Beth Ungo fondly remembers her time working alongside Dr. Montgomery and the care and kindness he provided to all he encountered. She said, "Dr. M was witty and loved to aggravate each of us. He always kept us on our toes, and always took time to explain clinical information and educate staff. He never gave up hope no matter what he encountered. He always wore a smile,

loved his family, the beach, music, and dancing. He was truly the heart of the oncology program." Dr. Barney Guyton also reflected on Dr. Montgomery's love for his craft and patients. He said of his friend, "He just loved what he did as much as anyone I have known. He always looked at his cases from an optimistic standpoint and never gave up."

Among his many passions, Dr. Montgomery loved flying, coin collecting and enthusiastically supporting Take a Swing at Cancer. He was instrumental in launching the grassroots effort to support cancer patients through more than just treatment. What began as a rummage sale in the cancer center parking lot to raise funds to support those in need grew into the fundraiser known as Take a Swing at Cancer, the largest amateur golf tournament in Mississippi. Dr. Montgomery was instrumental in helping grow this event into what it is today, all inspired by the needs he and his colleagues saw back in 1993. Today, Take a Swing at Cancer is an essential and vibrant beacon for the cancer care fund. In 2023, \$240,000 was raised to support this mission. These funds help provide transportation to treatment,



medicines, nutritional supplements, as well as financial assistance for other needs all to make cancer care just a little more manageable for those affected by the disease.

This year, it is only fitting that Dr. Montgomery be memorialized as the 2024 Take a Swing at Cancer's honorary chair. His contributions to cancer care and the community have reverberated throughout time and are still at work to support those dealing with cancer. Dr. Dick White remembered Dr. Montgomery by saying of his friend and colleague, "He left a huge legacy in the advancement of cancer care in our region and state. We are all indebted to him for choosing to make his home and life's work here in Mississippi and through North Mississippi Health Services. Dr. Montgomery lived a life well-lived and there is no more fitting tribute."
