

Ashleigh Pharr has held many important

titles throughout her life: veteran, mother, NMHS employee, Take a Swing at Cancer volunteer and so much more.

As someone who considers herself well-versed in the unexpected, the title of "cancer patient" was not one she expected to add to her list at the age of 37.

"Right before Christmas in 2023, I felt a lump," Pharr recalled. "At the time, I didn't think it was anything to worry about. I thought 'I'm young, healthy, and have two children.' However, on Jan. 12, 2024, my life changed in an instant when I was diagnosed with Stage 2 breast cancer."

Ashleigh immediately began treatment at North Mississippi Health Services Cancer Care. "I'm sure everyone reading this has been affected by cancer in some form. What they don't tell you about cancer is that there's a life before cancer and a life after cancer. In my life before cancer, I volunteered at Take a Swing at Cancer. I saw firsthand the support the Health Care Foundation provided to cancer patients and their families. I had friends who had benefited from the NMHS Cancer Care Fund during their own cancer journeys. I felt lucky and thankful



that I was able to reach out to HCF for help when I needed it.

From its inception, Take a Swing at Cancer has sought to raise funds for patients like Ashleigh. When unexpected diagnoses strike, HCF provides hope and support, enabling patients to focus on healing. Speaking about her own journey, Ashleigh said, "You can't-and shouldn't-fight it alone. My family, friends, co-workers, fellow veterans and amazing health care team have been right beside me. I was able to reach out to HCF when I needed it, knowing they would be right there in my corner. Thanks to events like Take a Swing at Cancer, they were able to jump to my aid without hesitation." Since her diagnosis, Ashleigh has undergone six rounds of chemo, a double mastectomy and 27 rounds of radiation. It is only fitting that she add Take a Swing at Cancer's Honorary Chair to her list of titles in the tournament's 27th year.
